COMPLETE entry = EITHER **emailed** with current Coggins & paid electronically will be accepted in order of date and time received via my email at pfb5678@aol.com OR **by mail postmarked** or **delivered** by closing date if spots are still available. *****INCOMPLETE entries will be entered on the Entries Wait List in the order they are completed with a Coggins and payment. Later complete entries will have to be wait-listed if the show is full.** Incomplete entries on 3/9 will be placed on the wait list regardless of whether or not the show is full; priority is order of completion. Non-sanctioned Division: "Greenies only" – must ride HC (judged but not pinned) if H&R also enter Starter

Baby Starter – 2023 USDF Intro B; Stadium: 18"- with cross rails and verticals; no oxers.

Jump outside. Warm clothes and gloves encouraged. Suede half-chaps are allowed but **note** - not in sanctioned divisions or other sanctioned shows; smooth snaffles only for dressage. Jumping not timed.

Sanctioned Divisions:

Modified	2026 Modified Test A	Stadium: 3ft.5in max (min. 3entries)
Prelim.	2026 Prelim Test A	Stadium: 3ft.7in max (min. 3 entries)

All dressage tests are in a small indoor arena and must be ridden from memory. Organizers reserve right to cancel divisions with insufficient entries. Divisions will be divided Junior/Senior if entries warrant.

****DOGS**** Stone Place Stables requests that visitors **do not bring outside dogs** - posted at entrance.

****Access to the Viewing Room is limited to food table purchases, packet pickup and show personnel in order to avoid crowding inside. Porta-lets are stationed near the Indoor and Jump rings.**

Schooling: Sorry, not available. *No grounds access by non-competitors or to warm-up areas by boarders.

Coggins: Dated **3/16/25 or later**. Do not send expired Coggins or health certificates.

Entry fees: Baby Starter & up = \$85* (*\$130 for two sequential divisions of same horse and rider)

***DISCOUNTS! - complete** entries (current Coggins, paid, entry scanned or **mailed** by closing date may take a \$5 discount per **rider**. No refunds if not taken at time of payment. Incorrect discounts will owe \$5 per rider at packet pick up. **Fleur-de-lis members** also get \$5 off – enter # on the entry.

Times: Posted on coveredbridgepc.org by 7:00PM, Wed 3/11 or call the Secretary after 7:00PM.

Limited Stabling: Text Debbie Snyder at 502-608-5117 to request stabling; payment is separate.

Refunds: Full refund if by closing date. After close, only if spot can be filled from the Wait List.

Call/text the Secretary right away in case of a scratch for best chance of refund.

*Cancellation of show for extreme weather - refund minus \$15 Office Fee to help defray fixed expenses.

Awards: Prize and ten ribbons per division. CBPC members are eligible for Club trophies.

Directions from Cincinnati/Lexington: Gene Snyder Freeway (I-265) north from I-64 or I-71 to last exit before the toll bridge - Exit 37. Right onto US Hwy 42 for 2.2 miles to Rose Island Rd (Hwy 3222 (cross from Marathon station). Turn left. Entrance is on the left down ½ mile; stone lion at gate.

Posted "No Outside Dogs". Secretary's Office is in the Indoor Viewing room in the Red Barn.

Food, snacks and drinks available in the Indoor Viewing Room. Venmo accepted - "Covered-Bridge"

Parking: Turn left at the intersection. All the big rigs need to pull down the driveway toward the Black Barn and find a space down there or turn around and park along the road; two-horse trailers should back into the spaces between the parked trailers on the right side of the road. Parking in front of the Hay Barn is for Spring Run trailer – not related cars - only. ***All cars must park in the Pond Field – left at the crossroad; the entrance is marked on the left side of the road near the pond.**
